

Chief Justice Closes Western Region Judicial Officers' Training

The Chief Justice, Justice Alfonse Chigamoy Owiny - Dollo, is presiding over the official closing ceremony of the week-long Western Region Judicial Officers' Training held at Las Vegas Garden Hotel in Mbarara City. The training, organised by the Judicial Training Institute (JTI), focused on Case Management, Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR), and Judgment Writing.

Upon his arrival, the Chief Justice was received by the Ag. Principal Judge, Lady Justice Okuo Jane Kajuga; the Director of Public Prosecutions, Justice Jane Frances Abodo; the Executive Director of JTI, Justice Andrew Khaukha; the Ag. As part of the day's programme, the Chief Justice is also set to officially launch a Mentorship and Guidance Programme for Judicial Officers, aimed at strengthening continuous professional development and nurturing judicial excellence across all court levels.
